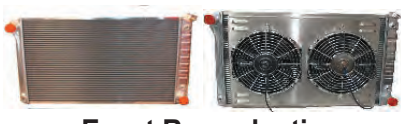

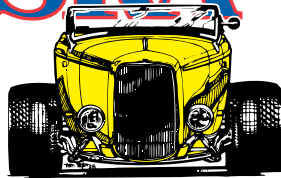

FAQ

It is against the law in Minnesota to misrepresent an animal as a service animal and is punishable by fines and jail time. Emotional support, therapy, comfort, or companion animals are not a service animal and their owners may be liable under this law. MN Statute 609.833.

> **CAN I OPERATE MY DRONE over the fairgrounds?** No, you cannot. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all visitors, the Minnesota State Fair prohibits unauthorized operation or use of any unmanned aerial vehicle on or above the Minnesota State Fairgrounds year-round. This includes all UAVs, commonly known as "drones," regardless of commercial or recreational purpose. Any UAV(s) observed at or near the Minnesota State Fairgrounds will be reported to local law enforcement and the Federal Aviation Administration.

The Committee's mission is to foster the advancement of legislation in the State of Minnesota that is favorable to the collecting, storing, constructing and safe usage of vehicles represented by the MSRA and its membership.

In carrying out its mission, the MSRA Legislative Committee:

- Monitors/watches for Minnesota legislation that has potential impact on our hobby (e.g. non-oxygenated fuel issue);
- Proposes legislation/provides support to legislation that is favorable to our hobby (e.g. exemption from emissions testing, non-oxygenated premium fuel exemption,

single license plate);

- Acts as a collection point and information resource for MSRA on legislative issues (i.e. *LineChaser*, articles, reprinted information, etc.);
- Acts as MSRA's liaison with other organizations to monitor, organize, coordinate and focus efforts on specific lawmaking issues (e.g. SEMA, MSMA, MCCC, etc.);
- Tracks national legislative trends (e.g. through SEMA membership, magazine and newspaper articles, etc.);
- Organizes events to promote legislative goodwill (e.g. legislative tent at Back to the 50's, Run to the Hill at the State Capitol, etc.); and
- Holds regularly scheduled meetings that are open to the membership.

Our goal is to work to legislatively protect and preserve our great hobby of street rodding.

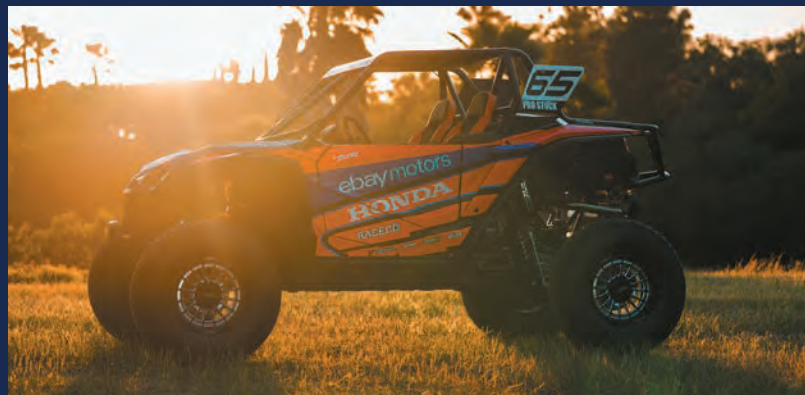

Then add a little entertainment from **Chuck Datko and his crew flying their T-6 Thunder planes making several passes over the fairgrounds Saturday morning around 11:00 am.** During the time of the Fly Over, Wings will be playing our National Anthem. So remember, watch for the T-6 Thunders Saturday!



The article below has been reprinted in its entirety from the LineChaser, as told by Chuck Datko.

Chuck Datko, #22417, was a Spartan car club member and then joined the Torquers in '64 when they were down on the island. He knew all of the old guys, like Jerry Johnson, Ron White and Billy Bissonett.

T-6 Thunder North American Flight Team formed 16 years ago and they are coming again to our Back to the 50's. The first year the group did a flyover at Back to the 50's, it was purely by chance. They were on our way back

from an air show and his brother, Frank #L-11145 suggested they fly over Back to the 50's. Then they met Terry Stade and the "rest is history."

The aircraft are all North American AT6s used during WWII for training and in the Korean War. They were called "forward air controllers." They would fly low and slow and mark targets. Then jets came in and did the bombing.

The group does an annual flyover for the Northern Knights who have a memorial service. As a matter of fact, they are mostly involved in vet funerals and memorials. Probably one half of their events are funerals. They've also entertained for the Minnesota Twins, the Vikings and Gophers, Concordia College and the Minneapolis Torchlight parade.

Street Rod and Custom of the Year Awards

Each year the Minnesota Street Rod Association presents awards for STREET ROD AND CUSTOM OF THE YEAR, one for Rod (pre '49) and one for Custom ('49-'64). In order to be eligible for this award the vehicles must first be selected through a series of "Voting Events" sponsored by MSRA and held around the area, hosted by MSRA or local member clubs. Each year there are six (6) such events with two Rods and one Custom selected at each event by the attending MSRA members.

VOTING

The rules for voting are:

1. All current MSRA members and their spouses attending the voting event with their membership card in their possession will receive a ballot.
2. Ballots will be issued only during the registration time.
3. All ballots MUST be returned during the time limit posted at the registration area.

SELECTION

1. Any current MSRA member's vehicle, pre '64, is eligible if it has passed the NSRA Safety Inspection and has a current Safety Inspection Sticker displayed on the window. The vehicle safety inspection requirements are listed elsewhere in this *Visitor's Guide*.
2. The previous year's Street Rod and Custom of the Year winners are not eligible.
3. The Street Rods and Custom nominated at an event

are automatically "in" for the remainder of the season.

4. All of the year's nominees are included in the Street Rod and Custom of the Year ballot distributed in November *LineChaser*. Each current member and spouse has one vote.

5. To be eligible for nomination for Custom of the Year, vehicles shall have a minimum of three (3) body modifications as verified by the MSRA board and display an MSRA Custom Certified sticker on the windshield.

As you see the competition is fairly simple. The important thing is to have your vehicle NSRA Safety inspected at the beginning of the season. Then attend the Voting Events and hope your rod or custom catches the eyes of enough fellow members to receive the event nomination.

What if you receive the nomination? You will be presented with an award plaque engraved with a likeness of your vehicle. You will receive the original four-color artwork, matted and ready for hanging. You will be a featured in Rodder Profile of the Month in the *LineChaser*. If voted the "Street Rod and Custom of the Year" winner, you will be awarded possession of the Traveling Trophy for a year, a five-foot replica of an antique gas pump for the Rod winner, or a louvered column with an Appleton spotlight for the Custom winner. You also receive a special plaque commemorating your Street Rod and Custom of the year win and the admiration of your fellow rodders.

Vehicle Safety Inspection Requirements

MSRA and NSRA both feel that safe vehicles are a very important part of the street rodding sport. Because of this, both associations use the NSRA Safety Inspection sticker as a requirement for consideration of many awards. In MSRA, you must have a current NSRA safety sticker to be eligible for MSRA Rod or Custom of the Year. If you have questions about the NSRA Safety program, please contact your NSRA Safety rep.



The National Street Rod Association® vehicle safety inspection may be voided by modifications or deterioration of any system components. A new inspection can be requested at any time and is recommended if modifications are made to the vehicle or any of its components. Certification sticker is not transferable.

Completion of the NSRA vehicle inspection warrants only that the vehicle complies with equipment requirements recommended by the National Street Rod Association®. The National Street Rod Association® vehicle safety inspection is only advisory and is not to be construed as an official legal clearance, and the National Street Rod Association®, its employees, officers, delegates, agents, or anyone assisting the Association assumes no responsibility for this advisory clearance.

All requests for safety division assistance should be directed to your division Chief Inspector.

Safety Inspections will be held: Thurs. 9-3 at the hotel, Fri. & Sat. 9-3 at the Fairgrounds

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

1. **HORN:** Electric only.
2. **SPEED INDICATOR:** Speedometer or calibrated tachometer at 55 mph.
3. **REAR VIEW MIRROR:** One inside or outside on driver's side of vehicle.
4. **GLASS:** Must be safety plate.
5. **LIGHTING:** Hi-beam; low-beam; tail; brake; license.
6. **WINDSHIELD WIPER:** Electric or vacuum operated.
7. **AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION LOCKOUT:** Neutral and/or park start only.
8. **TIRES:** Minimum 3/32" tread acceptable. Must meet D.O.T. specifications.
9. **STEERING:** No excessive "play" (2" radius max.) or binding; system must be safely mounted.
10. **THROTTLE LINKAGE:** Must not travel past center, return spring required.
11. **FUEL SYSTEM: CHECK VENT ON TRUNK AND INTERIOR MOUNTED TANKS:** no clear plastic lines allowed. No leaks.
12. **EXHAUST SYSTEM: NO LEAKS.** Must pass rear edge of front door and exit exhaust away from vehicle.
13. **SELF-ALIGNING ROD END BEARINGS:** Check for fractures, insert sloppiness or binding.
14. **SHOCK ABSORBERS:** One per wheel, no leaks, 2" travel in each direction.

15. **BRAKES:** Four-wheel brakes, no leaks, check brake pedal travel, no copper tubing, check length of flexible lines.

16. **SCRUB LINE:** No steering, suspension, or chassis components should be below this line.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT:

May be reason for failure.

17. **WINDSHIELD:** Should be AS-1.

18. **SHIFT PATTERN:** Shift pattern should be visible except on three speed standard column shift.

19. **FUEL LINES:** Should be safely mounted and routed.

20. **PARKING BRAKE:** Should be activated independent of vehicle's primary system. LINE-LOCK is not recommended.

21. **SELF - ALIGNING ROD END BEARINGS:** Ball should have 1/8 inch spacer on each side of the ball if there is any misalignment. Rod ends should not have more than 10 degrees misalignment. ROD ENDS and 4-BAR-PARALLEL RADIUS ROD SYSTEM rubber bushed ends should have a safety washer at least the same outside diameter as the housing or larger.

22. **BRAKE LINES:** Should be safely mounted and routed.

23. **CHASSIS FASTENERS:** Self-locking nuts, lockwashers, safety wire, or cotter pins.

24. **FOR YOUR SAFETY (Recommended, not required):**

- Fire extinguisher inside driver/passenger compartment;
- Seat belts;
- Third brake light.

No person shall operate, drive, or park a motor vehicle on any highway unless the vehicle is registered in accordance with the laws of this state and has the number plates or permit confirming that valid registration or operating authority has been obtained, except as provided in sections 168.10 and 168.12, subdivision 2f, as assigned to it by the commissioner of public safety, conspicuously displayed thereon in a manner that the view of any plate or permit is not obstructed. A plate issued under section 168.27 or a permit issued under chapter 168 may be displayed on a vehicle in conjunction with expired registration whether or not it displays the license plate to which the last registration was issued.

Subd. 2. **Semitrailer.**

If the vehicle is a semitrailer, the number plate displayed must be assigned to the registered owner and correlate to the documentation on file with the department.

Subd. 3. **Rear display of single plate.**

If the vehicle is a motorcycle, motor scooter, motorized bicycle, motorcycle sidecar, trailer registered at greater than 3,000 pounds gross vehicle weight (GVW), semitrailer, or vehicle displaying a dealer plate, then one license plate must be displayed horizontally or vertically, for a motorcycle issued vertical license plates under section 168.12, subdivision 2a, with the identifying numbers and letters facing outward from the vehicle and must be mounted on the rear of the vehicle.

Subd. 3a. **Small trailer.**

If the vehicle is a trailer with 3,000 pounds or less GVW with lifetime registration, the numbered plate or sticker must be adhered to the side of the trailer frame tongue near the hitch.

Subd. 4. **Collector's vehicle.**

If the vehicle is (1) a collector's vehicle with a pioneer, classic car, collector, or street rod license; (2) a vehicle that meets the requirements of a pioneer, classic, or street rod vehicle except that the vehicle is used for general transportation purposes; or (3) a vehicle that is of model year 1972 or earlier, not registered under section 168.10, subdivision 1c, and is used for general transportation purposes, then one plate must be displayed on the rear of the vehicle, or one plate on the front and one on the rear, at the discretion of the owner.

Subd. 5. **Truck-tractor, road-tractor, or farm truck.**

If the vehicle is a truck-tractor, road-tractor, or farm truck, as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 8, but excluding from that definition semitrailers and trailers, then one plate must be displayed on the front of the vehicle.

Subd. 6. **Other motor vehicles.**

If the motor vehicle is any kind of motor vehicle other than those provided for in subdivisions 2 to 4, one plate must be displayed on the front and one on the rear of the vehicle.

Subd. 7. **Plate fastened and visible.**

All plates must be (1) securely fastened so as to prevent them from swinging, (2) displayed horizontally with the identifying numbers and letters facing outward from the vehicle, and (3) mounted in the upright position. The person driving the motor vehicle shall keep the plate legible and unobstructed and free from grease, dust, or other blurring material so that the lettering is plainly visible at all times. It is unlawful to cover any assigned letters and numbers or the name of the state of origin of a license plate with any material whatever, including any clear or colorless material that affects the plate's visibility or reflectivity.

Subd. 8. **Plate registration stickers.**

As viewed facing the plates:

(a) License plates issued to vehicles registered under section 168.017 must display the month of expiration in the lower left corner of each plate and the year of expiration in the lower right corner of each plate.

(b) License plates issued to vehicles registered under section 168.127 must display either fleet registration validation stickers in the lower right corner of each plate or distinctive license plates, issued by the registrar, with "FLEET REG" displayed on the bottom center portion of each plate.

(c) License plates issued after July 1, 2008, requiring validation must display the month of expiration in the lower left corner of each plate and the year of expiration in the lower right corner of the plate.

Subd. 9. **Tax-exempt vehicle marking.**

Vehicles displaying tax-exempt plates issued under section 16B.581 or 168.012 must have vehicle markings that comply with section 168.012, subdivision 1.

Minnesota Statutes 2022 169.64 Prohibited Lights; Exceptions

Subd. 4. **Blue light.**

(d) A motor vehicle may display a blue light of up to one-inch diameter as part of the vehicle's rear brake light if:

(1) the vehicle is a collector vehicle, as described in section 168.10; or

(2) the vehicle is eligible to display a collector plate under section 168.10.

2022 Minn. Stat. 168.12 Subd. 2f. Original License Plates

(a) On application of the owner and in lieu of issuing plates under subdivision 1 to a motor vehicle registered and taxed as a passenger automobile, the commissioner may assign to the motor vehicle original Minnesota registration plates issued in the same year as the model year of the motor vehicle, if (1) the original plates are at least 20 years old, (2) the owner of the motor vehicle has the original plates in possession at the time of the application, and (3) the owner provides the plate number to the commissioner.

(b) Plates displayed under this subdivision, including stickers applied to the plates, must be clearly legible and must be displayed on the motor vehicle.

(c) The commissioner shall not assign the registration number on the original plates to the motor vehicle if

the commissioner determines that the number on the original plate is identical to the number on any plate in the current or reserved numbering system used by the commissioner.

(d) Despite subdivision 1, an original plate whose number has been assigned under this subdivision may be displayed for as long as the plates, including tabs and stickers on the plates, are clearly legible and the number is not subsequently used by the commissioner as a plate number in a registration numbering system.

(e) Despite subdivision 1, original plates assigned under this subdivision need not bear a tab or sticker to indicate the month or year of registration if the motor vehicle carries the registration certificate issued under section 168.11 at all times when the motor vehicle is operated on the public highways.

(f) The commissioner may charge a fee for receiving an application and assigning original plate numbers.

Help is Only Minutes Away



Our highly qualified First Responders, Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics are ready to render care for that “just in case” emergency medical situation you may encounter while attending the 2023 Back to the Fifties Weekend. The following information below will educate attendees what to do and what to expect if you or others you are with experience this type of emergency medical situation.

1.) First and foremost **STAY CALM!** Help is only minutes away.

2.) **GET HELP IMMEDIATELY:** Do not leave the injured or ill person alone. When possible send someone nearby to contact any staff member on a cart with a radio to dispatch First Responders to your area or call **651-632-2710**. They can also look around to see if any First Aid Team members are in the vicinity. When in doubt call **911**. If 911 is called please still try to contact and/or locate the First Aid Team volunteer at **651-632-2710** or an MSRA staff with a radio. The First Aid Team can and will immediately render care while 911 is in route.

3.) **STAY IN PLACE**.....once medical personnel are summoned, it will be easier for them to find your location. Staying in place will also prevent dispatch from sending multiple volunteer team members to the same medical situation.

What will Happen:

4.) A team of approximately 2 or 3 plus volunteer members will respond to assess the situation (sometimes on foot or by cart). Once medical personnel arrive they will begin to ask questions regarding the incident, obtain medical information, administer a first set of vital signs (blood pressure, pulse and respirations) and render first aid if necessary. First Aid Team personnel are instructed to record and complete a medical form for each incident where medical care was rendered per MSRA Board of Directors. At this time the staff will then determine the need and /or recommendation whether or not transportation by ambulance to a medical facility is necessary. If ambulance transportation is not necessary the patient will be requested to sign the medical form refusing transportation by ambulance.

5.) If transportation is recommended an ambulance will then be dispatched to the Fairgrounds to transport patient to the nearest appropriate facility.

6.) Some situations may not require immediate medical attention but may be recommended that you seek medical attention for your condition as soon as possible. You would then be advised to have a family member or friend drive you to the hospital or urgent care to see a physician. 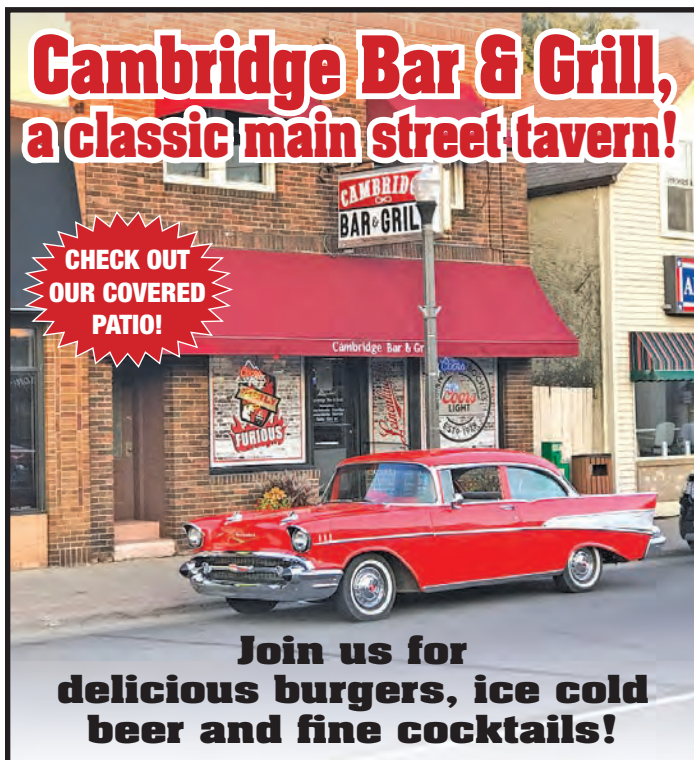

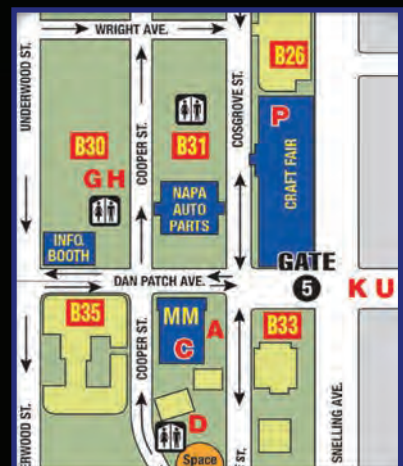
